Available Roles

- 6 female speaking roles
- 4 male speaking roles
- 16 kids speaking roles (ages 5 -17) Two must be boys, three must be girls, all other kids roles can be played by either a boy or a girl.
- Up to 4 in the adult chorus, unlimited kids chorus - No auditions required
- We need at least 6 kids with good singing voices to be in the angel choir - some of the angel choir can be played by other characters.

Lead Adult Roles

Individual auditions will be held for Adult lead roles.

Children's Roles

Group auditions will be held for kid's speaking roles

Teenagers

Teenagers should consider signing up for an individual audition because they may be considered for either older kids parts or adult roles.

Acting Portion of the Audition

One or several pieces of dialogue have been chosen for each character. This will be provided on the website. Someone will be on hand to read the lines of any other characters during your audition.

It is not necessary to memorize the piece prior to the audition but you should be familiar with the lines.

IMOGENE HERDMAN - loud, bossy, crafty, 11-12

LEROY HERDMAN - tough, sure of himself, 10-11

CLAUDE HERDMAN - tough, combative, 9-10

OLLIE HERDMAN - looking for trouble, Claude's usual partner in crime, 8-9
