

#### **Director;s Notes:**

How do you write a musical? It's like eating an elephant - one bite at a time. Where did I find the plot? Shakespeare and Clint Eastwood of course. I borrowed some of the storyline from Mid-Summer Night's Dream and some from "The Good, The Bad

and The Ugly". The music was easy, because it was set in the sixties. I mean, I used to dance to Beatles music in my crib. With such a great cast of seventy actors (between the ages of 7 and 80) and as many others working behind the scenes, putting this show together was never boring - expecially not with over 30 kids and teenagers involved. We've laughed together...and well...we've laughed some more together. Each member of the cast and crew has added to the play and made it something different, and better than I had ever imagined. Thanks everyone. And thanks especially to my Schmoopie! (I don't really call Paul that) who made sure I ate and slept and put gas in the car.

So sing along with the songs, help the kids introduce the Good, the Bad and the Nerdy, and enjoy the show. And while you're watching, think of all the great things we have right here, in the beautiful Ottawa Valley.

I hope you have as much fun watching the show as we've had putting it together -but I don't really think that's possible.

#### **Historic Notes:**

All events and characters depicted in the Good, the Bad and the Nerdy are fictional - well sort-of. For example, the AECL scientists were busy working on ING (the Intense Neutron Generator). There really was a floating stage that really did just about sink and an ox roast that went terribly wrong, but these happened in 1970, for Deep River's Jubilee. With a little poetic license these were moved back three years and included in the play.

Many of the characters in the play are based loosely on real, 1967 Deep Riverites. The characteristics of these characters are not meant, in any way, to be representative of the actual people. Their names have been used (closely) to remind us of the many talented people who helped develop nuclear energy in Canada and the community of Deep River. People such as Mr. and Mrs. J. L. Gray, Dr. and Mrs. Keys, George and Freda Laurence, and Dr. W. B. Lewis and his mother Isoline, have earned our respect and inspired some of the characters in the play.

So enjoy the Good, the Bad and the Nerdy for what it is -- a fictional comedy based on a real place and time.
